## 01. HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE

*The British resident Colonel Munro had his bungalow in the place where the present chapel has been built. In 1818, he offered the bungalow to Mr. Mead for his stay. Mr. Mead started the Mission Seminary which became the first educational institution in Travancore. Mr. Mead wrote the following about the seminary to his church in England. "This will rise, we hope, in time to a mission college for South India". In February 1893, the seminary was raised to a second grade college and named as 'Nagercoil Christian College' with 13 students (7 Christians and 6 Non-Christians). With the donation given by Septimus Scott, a new two storey building was built (opposite to the Main Gate) in 1889. Later the College was named after him. The main block was built in 1940. In 1970, Scott Christian College was shifted to the new campus in the Kottar-Parvathipuram Road. This College is recognized as a monument of the untiring, selfless and devoted service of the pioneer Christian missionaries.*

*On 13th June, 1973, Women's Christian College was started in this campus by the Kanyakumari Diocese of the Church of South India. Dr. Joy Gnanadhasan, wife of Moderator I.R.H. Gnanadhasan, was the founder Principal. To say about the buildings, each building has a story behind it which reminds us about the many great men like Rev. Charles Mead, Dr. James Duthie, Rev. G. Parker, Mr. G.H. Marsden, Mr. A. Nesamony and many others.*

*This lush green campus which carries the sacred memories of the missionary work is situated in the centre of the town. It was from this campus that the early Christian missionaries spread enlightenment to the areas around. Within a short span of fifty years, this College has created a niche for itself by providing quality learning for the holistic development of the students. Its motto "Enlightened We Serve" is appropriate to the mission it fulfills in the field of education. It offers 12 UG, 7 PG courses and 7 Ph.D. programmes. It has a student enrolment of more than two thousand three hundred girls.*

## 15. NSS / SPORTS

It is compulsory to stay back one hour in a week for NSS & games. 6 NSS units recognized by the M.S. University are functioning in our college for the betterment of the Society. ## 16. RULES AND REGULATIONS

### ATTENDANCE

- 1. Every student is expected to attend the classes regularly and should reach her class room on time.*
- 2. At the beginning of each period attendance will be marked.*
- 3. All the applications for leave signed by the parent or guardian or sub warden of the hostel and countersigned*

*by the class teacher and the Head of Department must be sent to the Vice-Principal before hand or on the day the student returns to the class.*

- 4. All leave applications must be sent in the prescribed form.*
- 5. Sick leave exceeding 4 days should be supported by a medical certificate. In any case, the medical certificate must reach the Head of the Departments within 5 days. Medical certificate submitted later will not enable a student to get condonation of shortage of attendance.*
- 6. Students will be fined for absence without leave at the end of the semester.*
- 7. Attendance for practical classes is compulsory. Those who do not have the minimum required attendance are not eligible for appearing for University examination.*
- 8. 75% attendance is required for appearing for the University Examinations.*

#### **CONDITION OF SHORTAGE OF ATTENDACE**

- 1. Those who have earned 75% of attendance can appear for the examination without any pre-condition.*
- 2. Those with an attendance of less than 75% but above 60% should pay condonation fee of Rs. 200 per paper.*
- 3. Those with less than 50% attendance should repeat the whole semester after completing the course, after getting necessary permission from the Registrar.*

#### **17. GENERAL DISCIPLINE**

- 1. When a student meets a member of the staff for the first time in the day, she must greet her appropriately.*
- 2. Students who come late may enter the classes only after obtaining the permission of the lecturer.*
- 3. No student shall leave the class room before the class is dismissed.*

4. *Students are expected to move quickly and quietly when they go from one class to another.*
5. *Students are not allowed to loiter in the verandah when classes are going on.*
6. *Students are forbidden to organize any meeting in the college or collect money for any purpose without the permission from the Principal.*
7. *Students not residing with parents or relations are expected to stay in the college hostel.*
8. *All changes in the residence should be reported forthwith to the college office.*
9. *Disobedience, malpractice in examinations, bad conduct, irregular attendance and non observance of the rules of the college will entail severe disciplinary action.*
10. *The college expects each student to be responsible for the safety of all personal property. Students who lose anything or find anything that does not belong to them must report to the college office.*
11. *The students should wear uniform.*
12. *Students should not bring cell phones to the college.*
13. *Lunch should be brought in boxes and not in packets as we have to keep the campus plastic free.*
14. *Drinking water should be used only for drinking and not for washing hands or lunch boxes.*
15. *Flowers and plants in the gardens are a delight to the aesthetic sense and not for plucking.*
16. *Students should strive to keep the campus clean and beautiful.*

17. *Students may call home for any emergency from the 'Logos', our centre for the physically challenged, after getting the permission from the head of the Department.*
18. *Students should make use of the 'Logos' for their lamination photocopying, spiral binding and computer typing needs so as to help the physically challenged of our college.*
19. *The college expects all students to attend the regular assembly as well as the special functions organized by the college or the students' council.*
20. *Students should read the notices posted on the notice boards but should not tamper with the notices displayed.*
21. *During holidays, non-resident students are permitted to come to college only with the prior permission of their department Heads.*
22. *Students should not go to the canteen during class hours.*
23. *Students should wear their ID cards regularly to college.*
24. *Students are expected to talk in English when they are inside the campus.*

### **LIBRARY REGULATIONS**

6. *On receiving a book, the student must examine and report to the librarian any damage that is found. If she fails to do so, she will be held responsible for any damage and may be asked to pay the cost of the book.*
7. *Each student is responsible for the books borrowed by her. For any damage or loss of book, its cost will be collected.*
8. *If a book is lost, the borrower is to inform the librarian immediately to avoid overdue fine.*
9. *Students are prohibited from bringing personal books, umbrellas, boxes and other personal belongings when they enter the library.*
10. *The text books are available to poor deserving students for a semester from the Book Bank on payment of a nominal fee Rs. 10/- per semester. For this, an application duly signed by the Head of the Department should be submitted to the librarian.*
11. *Books borrowed during the old semester holidays should be returned within 3 days after the reopening of the college.*
12. *Reprographic section serves the users with photocopying facilities.*
13. *Computers with internet access for academic browsing are available in the library.*
14. *Browsing can be done only during lunch break and after college hours.*
15. *The library committee consisting of the librarian and some members of the faculty meet at intervals to consider problems pertaining to the library and give suggestions for the improvement of library facilities. Any complaint or suggestion regarding the library may be dropped in the suggestion box kept in the library which will be attended to by the committee.*
16. *The facilities in the audio visual room may be used by the students and staff during class hours or leisure hours. Students must be accompanied by a staff member.*



## 18. COLLEGE STUDENTS' COUNCIL

*(Based on the guidelines of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University MSUIA/A/Co.UN.EL/2007-08)*

### ARTICLE I - NAME

- ◆ *The names of the council shall be College Students' Council and here in after referred to as the Council.*

### ARTICLE II - OBJECTIVES

- ◆ *To provide leadership training and bring out the latent talents of the students.*
- ◆ *To promote cultural and intellectual co-operation among the students.*
- ◆ *To make the students enlightened citizens by arousing their civic consciousness.*
- ◆ *To strive to develop character, discipline, sense of responsibility, honesty, integrity and efficiency among students.*
- ◆ *To organize meetings, debates, symposia, seminars and study circles which will involve students' participation.*

### ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

*All regular students of the college shall be the members of the council. In the event of the college opting for indirect election, there shall be an electoral college, comprising of all the representatives of all the classes both UG and PG, which will elect the Chairperson and the Secretary.*

### ARTICLE IV - COMPOSITION OF THE COUNCIL

*The College Students' Council will have four office-bearers. They are : Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Secretary and*

*Joint Secretary, six more members will be elected to the Executive Committee, the total strength of which, inclusive of office-bearers, should not, however, exceed ten.*

#### **ARTICLE V - MODE OF ELECTION**

*The College will have the option of following either direct or indirect election method, keeping the local conditions in mind, to select the student representatives. In the system of direct election, all students of the college will vote directly for the election of office bearers and the members of the Executive Committee. Under indirect election method, each class (major wise) I, II and III years of undergraduate courses, I & II years of post graduate programmes and M.Phil., programme will elect a representative each and all these class representatives will form the Electoral College to elect the office-bearers and members of the Executive Committee directly.*

#### **ARTICLE VI - ELIGIBILITY**

*Candidates contesting for the posts of Chairperson (Council Chairperson) and Secretary (Council Secretary) of the Council.*

- a. Should be a regular full time student of aided / unaided courses.*
- b. Should be from final year UG*
- c. Should at least have 85% attendance in the previous academic years in the college.*
- d. Should have passed 100% of the papers whose results stand declared by the University / College as on date.*
- e. Should not have criminal antecedents*
- f. Should not have affiliation to any political or communal outfit and*
- g. There shall not be disciplinary action of any kind whatever against her.*

## **ARTICLE VII - NORMS ON CAMPAIGNS IN COUNCIL ELECTION**

*The following norms, as per Government Orders/ Supreme Court directives/University guidelines should be followed strictly during the election campaigns. Any violation of the norms by the candidate or agents or supporters shall entail disqualification:*

- a. No outsider is permitted to play any role in the election process; not shall any outsider be allowed into the campus during the days of election.*
- b. Posters, wall-writing, use of microphones/megaphones or other campaign materials are prohibited. Printed wall posters, pamphlets and handbills are banned.*
- c. Use of any means of enticing the students/corrupt practices such as offering gifts, eats and drinks are totally prohibited.*
- d. Seeking votes in the name of caste, community, religion, political and other affiliations is not permitted.*
- e. Any attempt to instigate or indulge in violence will disqualify the candidate.*
- f. No election related expenditure will be permitted.*
- g. No procession, either campaign or victory, should be permitted within or outside the campus. In the event of violence or factional clashes, the Election Commission will cancel the whole election process and inform the decision to the University authority concerned.*

## **ARTICLE VIII - CONDUCT OF ELECTION**

- a. The College Council reserves the right to choose the mode of election, direct/indirect.*
- b. Each college, through its college council shall setup an Election Commission.*
- c. The Election Commission, appointed by the College Council, shall have the responsibility of conducting the election to College Students' Council.*

- d. *Appointment of impartial teachers as observers is also desirable.*
- e. *The duration of the process of election shall not exceed four days in a college.*
- f. *A Grievance Cell constituted by the College Council (Staff Council) will dispose of the election related disputes and complaints within twenty four hours.*
- g. *The Grievance Cell will have authority to cancel the candidate of a contestant who violates the code of conduct and/or norms of election. The Grievance Cell will cease to exist immediately after the election.*

#### **ARTICLE IX - EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE**

*The Council Chairperson, the Vice-Chairperson, the Council Secretary, the joint Secretary and the elected representative shall constitute the Executive Committee. The office bearers and the elected representatives will not hold the post of the Secretary of any UG or PG Association / Club.*

#### **ARTICLE X - ADVICE AND ORIENTATION TO STUDENTS COUNCIL**

- a. *A teacher consultant will be appointed by the College Council as advisor to the College Students' Council.*
- b. *A workshop will be organized by the college to orientate the student leaders to the new responsibility.*

#### **ARTICLE XI - ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

*The Vice-principal, the Bursar, the Secretary of the Staff Association and the Staff Representative to the Governing Board, Teacher Senate Member, the Teacher Consultant and the Office Superintendent shall be the members of the Advisory Committee and shall be ex-officio members of the Executive Committee and will have no voting right.*

#### **ARTICLE XII - COUNCIL MEETINGS**

- a. *The Executive Committee shall meet only with the prior written consent of the Principal.*
- b. *The quorum for the meeting of the Executive Committee*

*shall be one third of the voting members of the Executive Council.*

- c. The Chairperson shall convene the Executive Committee meetings and shall preside over all meetings arranged under the auspices of the College Students' Council.*

### **ARTICLE XIII - FUNCTIONS OF THE SECRETARY**

*The Secretary shall organize all the activities of the Students' Council such as meetings, debates, symposia and seminars with the prior approval of the Principal / Advisory Committee / Teacher Consultant and also maintain a record of all the activities of the Council and the proceedings of the Executive Committee.*

### **ARTICLE XIV - NON INTERFERENCE IN INTERNAL ADMINISTRATION**

*The office-bearers/executive committee shall have no right to interfere in matters concerning student discipline or the internal administration of the college which shall be the prerogative of the Principal.*

### **ARTICLE XV - CODE OF CONDUCT**

*The office-bearers/executive committee shall neither participate in strikes nor instigate other students to strike or to boycott classes or to indulge in acts of lawlessness and violence, but shall endeavour their best to settle all disputes by peaceful negotiation with the authorities concerned.*

*No office-bearer of the College Council shall publish any report about the college in papers nor take any matter concerning the college to the Court of Law without the prior written permission of the Principal.*

### **ARTICLE XVI - REMOVAL OF OFFICE-BEARERS**

*If, in the opinion of the Principal, the activities of the office-bearers of the Council are against the smooth working of the college, the Principal reserves the right, either to remove from office the erring office-bearer/office-bearers or to suspend the activities of the Council.*

## **19. HOSTEL RULES**

*Accommodation in the hostel is given only to students of the college.*

*The Principal is the Warden of the Hostel. The College provides residential accommodation for 120 students. At least one meeting in each semester is held to consider matters of concern to the resident students.*

*Application for hostel accommodation must be made to the Principal. For withdrawal from the hostel a student must submit a letter of request from the parent or guardian to the Principal through the Sub Warden at least 15 days in advance. Mess charges are collected from the members from the 5th to the 10th of every month. Fine will be levied for late remittance.*

*The hostel has a small library, audio-video facilities and indoor games. The college courts can be used for outdoor games.*

*Roll call will be taken every day at 6.15 P.M. and after that there will be prayers.*

*Study time is from 6.30 P.M. to 8.00 P.M. Silence must be maintained from 10.00 P.M. to 8.00 A.M. During study hours the students are expected to come to the study hall.*
